

THEME SONG COMPETITION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Theme song competition is open to all Rivers State indigenes and persons resident in Rivers State who want to write their names in gold.

EACH ENTRY MUST INCLUDE:

1. Entry form – filled out clearly and completed with an original signature. Entry Forms can be printed out or (photocopied) from the competition website at www.ourstateourresponsibility.com.
Completed forms and entry material should be sent to this email address: rsministryofinformationandcoms@gmail.com.
2. Each entry's total running time must not be over 3 minutes in length.
3. Songs that are submitted must be the entrant's original work and shall not infringe on any copyrights or any other rights of any third parties.
4. By entering the competition, the entrant agrees that the Theme Song Competition will not be held liable for any copyright infringements perpetrated by you or your song. The Theme Song Competition reserves the right not to screen any song(s) or any reason it deems valid.
5. Winners will be required to sign an affidavit confirming that their song is original and he/she holds all rights. Failure to sign and return the form within the required time period (30 days) or provision of false information may result in disqualification and an alternate winner may be selected.
6. Affidavits of winners under 18 years of age at time of award must be countersigned by Parent or Legal guardian. Affidavits are subject to verification by the Theme Song Competition and its agents.
7. Entrants will retain all ownership rights to their songs submitted.

Entry materials submitted will not be returned to the entrant. The Theme Song Competition is not responsible for late, loss, damaged, misdirected, postage due, stolen, or misappropriated entries.

8. Winners are selected by a judging panel of industry professionals consisting of a Musician, On Air Personality and a DJ. All entries are judged equally based on these 4 areas: Content Originality, content alignment with Theme, Production, Sound quality (Clarity, consistency of audio levels, and lack of noise).
9. Winners will be awarded on and will be notified by phone or email and will also be listed on the competition website. The Theme Song competition will use its best efforts to announce the winners at the designated time, but will not be held liable for any unforeseen delays.
10. By entering the Theme Song Competition, contestants and/or their parents or legal guardian (if such entrant is a minor) agree to accept and be bound by the decisions of the competition and its judges which are final and binding in all matters. Entrant agrees to be bound by all terms of these official competition rules and regulations as established herein.
11. The Theme Song Competition reserves the right to extend the competition deadline for any unforeseen reasons if needed. Entry constitutes permission to use winner's name, likeness, and voice for future advertising and publicity purposes without additional compensation.
